PALM TREES TO SUBSTITUTE FOR QUEEN PALMS

Every house in Bent Tree is required to have 3 large palm trees in the front yard as originally planted when each house was built.

Because of Fusiriam Wilt, other diseases and hurricane damage it is not advisable to replant the Queen Palms.

The height of replacement palm trees must be a minimum of 10' to 12' measured from the ground to the arc of the tallest frond.

Below is a list of palm trees approved as a substitute for the Queen Palm:

Foxtail Palm - #1 choice, recommended by the City Forester for Size, hardiness & beauty

Lububensis Palm Christmas Palm(Adonidia) Sabal Palm Miraguama Palm Princess Palm Montgomery Palm

All other trees must first be approved by the Architectural and Landscape . Committees.

The following palms are not approved as a substitute for the Queen Palm:

Royal Palm Coconut Palm Roebelenii Pigmy Date Palm Fan Palm Bottle Palm

NOTE: Multi trunk palms are considered one tree.
